Brief description of activities provided	<p>Only 10 minutes west of Perth's central business district, the Subiaco Arts Centre is a multi-purpose venue surrounded by magnificent gardens.</p> <p>The Centre boasts three dedicated performance areas including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Auditorium with a corner stage and raked seating three sides for 305. • The Studio with an intimate performance area seating 115 • Subiaco Theatre Gardens with a stunning amphitheatre for outdoor concerts. <p>Subiaco Arts Centre is home to Yirra Yakin Theatre Company, Barking Gecko Theatre Company and The Actors' Hub.</p>

Parking facilities for cars and buses	<p>Parking</p> <p>Parking for 67 cars and 8 motorcycles is available in the Theatre Gardens Carpark which can be accessed from Bagot and Hamersley Roads. Parking is free after 6pm Monday to Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday. At other times the cost is \$0.20 per 12 minutes. Alternative parking for 90 cars is available at the Rowland Street Carpark. Rowland Street runs from Bagot to Barker Roads and is an approximate 5 minute walk from the Centre. It has a 3 hour time limit, first hour of parking is free after which is charged at 20c per 9 minutes.</p> <p>Accessible Parking - 3 ACROD parking bays are available in the Theatre Gardens Carpark.</p>

	<p>Transport</p> <p>Transperth Bus 25 from St George's Terrace (after William St stop 10089) stops on Hamersley Road.</p> <p>Transperth's Bus Services 27 and 26 from Wellington Street Bus Station stops on Bagot Road.</p> <p>The Subiaco Railway Station is within 15 minutes walking distance from the Centre, and the DalGLISH Railway Station just 10 minutes walk away.</p> <p>Transperth Bus Service 28 from Wellington Street stops at Hay and Rokeby Roads.</p>
<p>Emergency Evacuation Plan</p>	<p>Emergency Evacuation Plan</p> <p>Perth Theatre Trust has formulated an Emergency Evacuation Plan to enable the reporting of emergency and fire situations and for the safe evacuation of any persons within this situation.</p> <p>Subiaco Arts Centre utilises two alarms to warn of a fire or other situations which may require the evacuation from the venue.</p> <p>Alert Tone</p> <p>The <i>Alert Tone</i> consists of a series of short sharp beeping sounds (beep, beep, beep). This signifies an incident has occurred and requires you to cease your activity (turn equipment off, commence shut down operations), identify fire exits in your immediate area and stand by for further announcements or advice from venue staff.</p> <p>(Note if the emergency incident is in your immediate proximity, then remove yourself and others in order to safeguard yourselves, evacuate to the nearest fire exit.)</p> <p>Evacuation Tone</p> <p>If the emergency situation continues, the <i>Evacuation Alarm</i> will sound. The evacuation tone consists of a series whooping tones (whoop, whoop, whoop).</p> <p>This is the automatic signal to immediately evacuate yourself and others in the area to the nearest fire exit and leave the building.</p> <p>Assist non-ambulatory persons, if present in your immediate area and evacuate to the assembly site located on the grassed area approx. 100m out from the end of the ramp.</p> <p>If unable to assemble at this location, then locate at either of the two alternate assembly areas on Hamersley or Hensmen Rd.</p> <p>Stay at your location until advised by the Western Australia Fire and Rescue Service or Chief Warden in charge of the incident.</p> <p>Perth Theatre Trust (PTT) requires that if you are undertaking work in any PTT venue that you familiarise yourself with the venues fire exits, firefighting equipment locations and emergency warning systems within the venue.</p>



Fire and Evacuation – Medical Notification

In the event of discovering a fire or notifying of an emergency incident (including medical emergency) you should contact any Perth Theatre Trust Management and do the following:

- Contact the nearest venue management or staff member,
- If unable use your personal mobile phone and dial either **000** or *Subiaco Arts Centre* venue management on:
